



Information for day trip visitors

Directions to Keauhou Bay

Directions if Traveling From the North:

- If staying in the Waikoloa area allow 1 hour of travel time.
- Our cruises depart from Keauhou Bay, which is about 35 miles from Waikoloa.
- Drive south on Hwy 19/Hwy11 for about 33 miles, which is towards the airport.
- Turn Right on to Kamehameha III road and continue downhill to the second traffic light.
- Turn left on Alii Hwy and continue to the next traffic light.
- Turn right on Kaleiopapa Street and follow it until it dead ends on the pier.

Directions if Traveling From the South:

- If you are in the Captain Cook or Honaunau area along Hwy 11, plan on 30-45 minutes of travel time.
- Drive North on Hwy 11, which is towards the airport. The ocean should be on your left side.
- Turn left on to Kamehameha III road and continue downhill to the second traffic light.
- Turn left on Alii Hwy and continue to the next traffic light.
- Turn right on Kaleiopapa Street and follow it until it dead ends on the pier.

Directions from Ali'i Drive to Keauhou Bay:

- If you are in the Kailua-Kona area along Alii Drive, plan on 20 minutes of travel time.
- Our cruises depart from Keauhou Bay, which is approximately 6 miles south of downtown Kailua-Kona.
- Drive south along Alii Drive. The ocean should be on your right side.
- Take a right at the traffic light on to Alii Hwy and continue through the next traffic light.
- Turn right at the second traffic light onto Kaleiopapa Street and follow it until it dead ends on the pier.

Parking is available on the pier and along Kaleiopapa Street. Please be aware of "No Parking" signs in the area.
